* **Moving up to the next level** – You need to show continuous improvement in order to move up to Intermediate level A. You also need to attend classes regularly and have a good attitude to learning. Your progress will be monitored through your assessment scores. In order to move to Intermediate level A your average score should be above 75%.

Your score will be based on the completion of at least five weekly tests, which includes a minimum of one grammar test (these tests take place in Weeks 4 and 8).
